



Surgical/Procedural Safety Practices

For your safety and the safety of those around you, the following measures have been implemented for your upcoming surgical/procedural visit:

- When you enter the hospital, you will be given a mask. Please place this over your nose and mouth immediately.
- You will receive instructions specific to your procedure, but in the event you are allowed one visitor to accompany you for all or part of your stay, they also will be given a mask to wear.
- Please continue to wear the mask any time you are unable to keep an appropriate social distance of at least 6 feet.
- Likewise, you should expect all staff members involved in your care to be wearing a mask during each encounter with you.
- Any time you and/or your visitor are in a waiting room, please observe the blocked seats and allow at least one chair in between you and any other person.
- Please ensure you self-quarantine after you have had your COVID-19 test.
